Solutions
④ Return New BSRs?

- Allow members to stand up for positions out of their own interest. ~~No Admits~~ No Voluntary people when they are absent.
- Make sure groups & members are aware of what they are getting into.
- Get prospects to assemblies and get ~~at~~ a feel of what it's about.
- Offer positive encouragement to BSRs & ALT BSRs.
- Put max mtg time and sharing times to limit overwhelmed feeling.
- Help BSRs by giving ~~the~~ list of important items to bring back to groups.
- Just do what you're told - No more no less.
- 1 volunteer is better than 10 pressed men. Make it all attractive to projects over →

- Ask GRS if they have issues within their group.
- Have conversations on how GRS help fellow AAs by their service.
- Give new GRS orientations by elder statesmen.
- Open up eyes of new GRS that AA is bigger than your own backyard.
- Offer positive encouragement to GRS.
- Put max effort into and sharing stories to limit overwork and fatigue.
- Help GRS to be good at what they do. Important items to bring back to groups.
- Just be what you are.
- Volunteer is better than to pressure. Make it all attractive to people.
